Elizabeth loved gardening and she worked around the kingdom planting and gardening for many years. She taught many how to garden and was always helping the friends with their gardens, doing whatever she could to help anyone who needed a hand. She always had a willing spirit.

Elizabeth loved helping out with the Pioneer school, by feeding and assisting the pioneers for years, until she was no longer able to do it physically. She was extremely hospitable and always had friends over for meals, including the circuit overseers and their wives. She was known for her tasty chicken salad that she prepared for the assemblies and regional conventions for many years.

On November 21, 2018, Elizabeth fell asleep in death. She was preceded in death by her mother Lizzie.
