Eugene Camble was born on September 27, 1953 in New Orleans, Louisiana to the union of the Theropes Camble and Clara Camble. He was the fifth child of nine children.

Eugene attended Betsy Ross Elementary School where he graduated eighth grade and went on to Englewood High School where he received his GED certificate.

Eugene was a very hard worker. He began his working career at University of Chicago. In 1998, he became a Case Manager at Heartland Alliance Healthcare, where he worked with Alcoholics Anonymous drug addicted and mental health clients.

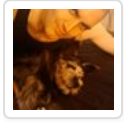
