Kelley Boyd was born October 28, 1976 to Rose Randle in Chicago, Illinois. He was adopted, raised as a son and loved by his aunt/mother Shirley Boyd-Lee and Isiah Lee.

Kelley attended Walter Reed Elementary School and Hubbard High School on the south-side of Chicago. He was a loving son and a good brother. In high school his art teacher said he was a natural artist. His first job, at age 16 in 1992, was working on a mural at Gallery 37 downtown. He was proud of his work. He also liked basketball and played on his middle school team for which he won a trophy for his achievements.

In 1993, Kelley was shot and this changed his life forever. The incident left him paralyzed on his right side; confining him to a wheelchair. Upon returning home after a long stay in Christ Hospital, he started physical therapy at Schwab. Even when it was hard to do things physically, Kelley managed to continue high school; graduating in 1997 from Jesse Spaulding High School. He later attended Harold Washington College downtown. He really enjoyed going to the mall, listening to music (Tupac being his favorite), watching movies, and having people around to spend time with him. Kelley was very smart and still had a sense of humor despite his situation.

On November 29, 2016, Kelley Boyd departed this life peacefully at home. He was preceded in death by his biological mother, Rose Randle.

Kelley leaves to cherish his memories, his mother, Shirley; his father, Isiah; grandmother, Essie; sisters, Tiffany, Sophilia, Angela and April; brothers, Holland, John, Mickey and Toxsy; nephews, LaMario, DJ and others; nieces, cousins, aunts, uncles, a great-aunt Dorine; as well as a host of other relatives and friends.
