Pauline Neely was born February 28, 1945 in Indianole, Mississippi to William Loggins and Hattie Lee Loggins. She was one of 10 children to bless her parents union.

The family moved to Chicago in the 1950's. Pauline completed her formal education and moved on to take classes in early childhood development.

Pauline's love of God led her to study the Bible with Jehovah's Witnesses.
