Anthony L. Slaughter was born to the union of Leroy and Mary Slaughter on January 28, 1961.

Tony attended Grammar School in the Chicago area and graduated from Jones Commercial High School as an honor student. He retired from AT & T Phone Company after 30 years of service in 2011.

At the age of 14, Tony dedicated his life to Jehovah God and symbolized it by water baptism on April 5, 1975. He united in marriage with the love of his life, Robin Wright on July 24, 1982. They served Jehovah as a happy married couple until his death for 33 wonderful years.

His special privileges of services included being a Regular Pioneer, Substitute Circuit Assembly Overseer and Congregation Overseer at the Lake Calumet Congregation. Tony also had the pleasure of being one of the Instructors for the Kingdom Ministry School for Elders and Pioneer Service School. He had the privilege of directing many Bible dramas at the conventions of Jehovah's Witnesses.
