Dee cared for her clients just as she did for her own children. Dee loved her responsibilities and position!

Dee also volunteered for many years as a Poll Worker for the Village of University Park during elections. Dee had a “giving spirit” which she inherited from her mother. Dee provided shelter for many troubled youth within the

neighborhood. Dee often provided shelter as well for women and their children who were in domestic dispute situations within their homes for safety.

In 1990, after giving birth to her second son, Dee developed a debilitating illness. Dee was diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis. Dee continued with the help of her “village” to live independently however, her MS progression became too much which caused a need for 24/7 around the clock care. In 2008, Dee became a resident of Beecher Manor until her passing on June 6, 2021.

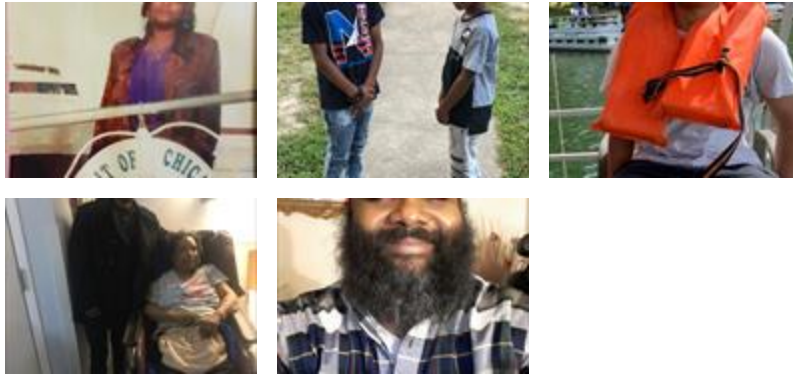
