Carl Leroy Pitts Jr. was born in Chicago, Illinois on October 31, 1949. He was the oldest son of three born to Carl Leroy Pitts Sr. and Gertha Muse.

Carl graduated from Dunbar Vocational Career Academy High School and attended Richard M. Daley College. He served his country in Vietnam by completing one tour of duty and was honorably discharged in 1972.

Carl was an entrepreneur and an incredible sales man. After running his own street vending business for several years he decided to get into the car dealership business. This proved to be something that he was incredibly gifted in as he made top sales agent many times at various dealerships and was in high demand. Carl was known as the "go-to-guy", if you needed a difficult deal closed. Many were taken in by his near 6'6" stature and how well dressed he always was.

Carl enjoyed learning about the Bible and tried often to understand its teachings as he searched for meaning in life. He once visited the Kingdom Hall of Jehovah's Witnesses with his step-daughter Terra, where he said coming into the main auditorium, "These brothers almost dress as good as I do!" He also enjoyed conversations with the brothers when they would visit him at home.

On Saturday, August 6, 2016, Carl fell asleep in death in East Chicago, Indiana. He was preceded in death by his father, Carl Leroy Pitts Sr. and one son, Carl Pitts III.
