Carol Ann Hampton was born October 23, 1948 in Chicago, Illinois to the union of Charles and Susie Nelson. She was the second of three daughters born to that union. Carol grew up on the west side of Chicago where she attended Howe Elementary School and Farragut High School. While she was in high school she volunteered as a candy striper at Mt. Sinai Hospital. She also worked part-time at Turner Bros. Picture Frame Co. in 1965 where she met her husband Joseph.

Carol and Joseph were married 47 years ago on February 24, 1968. To this union, there was one step-son and three children born.

Before becoming a stay at home mom, Carol worked five years for Smoler Bros. Apparel Co. as a cost analyst and ten years for the Prairie Hill School District in charge of the districts lunch program.

Carol dedicated her life to Jehovah and symbolized her dedication through water baptism on April 23, 1983. For the next 32 years, she and her family never missed the annual assemblies.

Carol loved to shop at her favorite places, Carson Pirie Scott and QVC. Even more than shopping, she loved people. If she was in line at a store with four or five people, she would know something personal about at least two of them

before she got to the cash register. Because of her kindness and loving spirit, strangers would just pour themselves out to her.
