Carolyn Jean Ranson was born November 4, 1954 in Chicago, Illinois to the parents of Walter and Rosetter Ranson. Carolyn was one of ten children, one of her family members referred to her as "little Ma' dear".

She learned about Jehovah in her youth and from there Carolyn did not turn back. 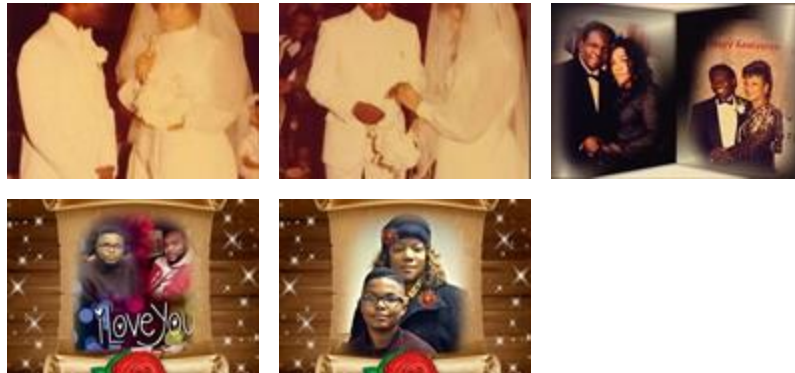
