She worked at the Sweetheart Paper Cup Company. Her next home of employment was Stewart & Warner (making car parts), followed by her very own family business Guy's Eats & Sweets during the 70s. Christine enjoyed attending family functions, going to bingo, the casino, and traveling. Christine was a 40 year Breast Cancer Survivor. She was a caring worker. Loved by everyone that met her. She had the most beautiful smile. She was a wonderful mother and wife, and the best sister and aunt in the universe.

She was baptized at an early age at Mount Olive in Sandy Hook, Mississippi. In 1955, during her marriage to Walter Guy Jr., she joined Fellowship Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Reverend Clay Evans. In 1968, she joined the Church Without A Spot or Wrinkle in Chicago, under the late Rev. C. Odom. Her final fellowship would be under her granddaughter Pastor Sheta Johnson of Delightful Living Ministries.

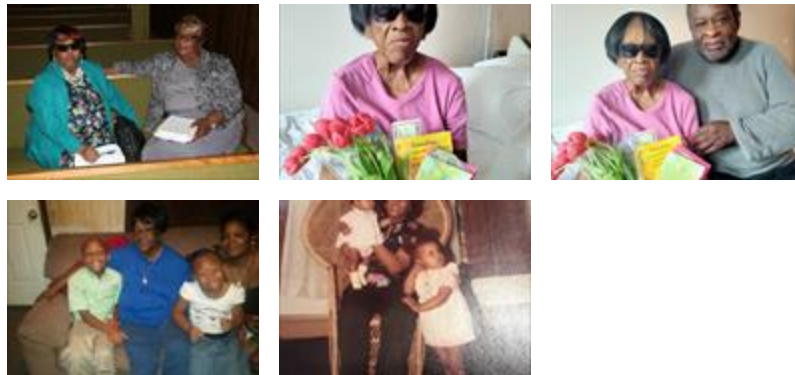
