Christine attended and graduated from Bremen High School in 1968. While in high school she joined the modern dance club called "Orchises". She enjoyed dancing and performing with them. After high school she received an Associates Degree in Nursing, becoming a Registered Nurse.

On November 6, 1971, she was united in holy matrimony with Robert Lee Holloway. To this union two daughters were born, Camelle and Channon.
