Clarence Milton Logan Sr. was born March 27, 1935 in Tunica, Mississippi to Arnold Logan and D'enie Logan. Clarence moved to Chickago, Illinois in the early 50s. Clarence married Ruthie Mae Hatcher on May 26, 1956. To this union eight children were born.

Clarence worked at Midland Ross Steel Mill for 30 years before retiring as steel chipper. Clarence was known for his kind heart and his willingness to help anyone in need.

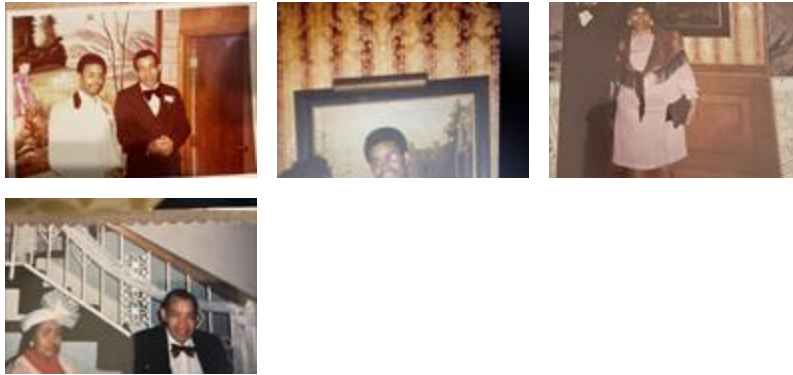
