August 3, 1918 - November 22, 2014

Dora Lee Parker "Sista" was born on Saturday, August 3, 1918 in BoBo, Mississippi to Charlie Maxon and Sofia Williams. She was the second of six siblings to include two brothers and three sisters.

Dora met and later married Alfred Parker on Wednesday, January 29, 1947. Their loving union of marriage lasted 28 years until Alfred's death in July 1975.

Dora sought Christ and confessed in Him as her Lord and Savior at an early age. She joined Christ Temple No. #2 Church of Holiness U.S.A in the early 1960's under the leadership of the Emeritus Reverend Marcus Irons. She served on the Usher Board for many years.
