Over the past three years she became amazed with the smartphone and was the character for many family funniest video moments. She lived her life without walls and broke many glass ceilings

Ernestine, better known as "The Duchess", was considered a Southern Bell. When you saw her she was always dressed from head to toe. Adorned with her gloves and hats to match every purse and shoe, bling on every finger, and she would not be caught without her purple lipstick.

On Thursday, December 8, 2016, Ernestine fell asleep in death, late in the evening after her normal morning of seeing her twin boys off to work, and talking to her baby girl on the phone. Ernestine's mother, father, sister and husband Willie Thompson all preceded her in death.

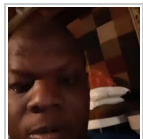

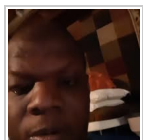

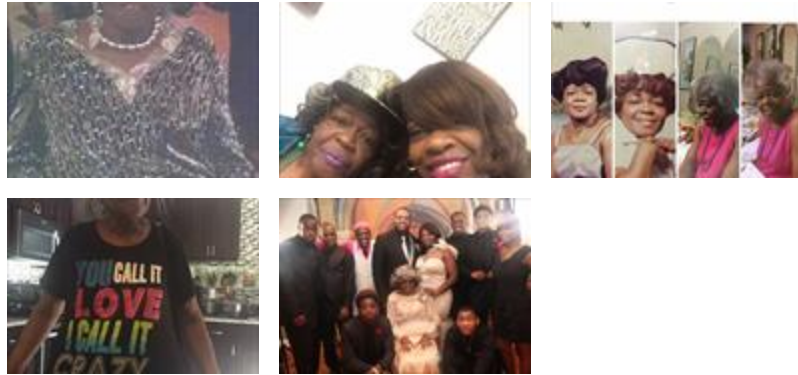
