Ethel Patton was born to James Ross Sr. and Mary Stewart on March 30, 1927 in Greenwood, Mississippi.

In 1939, Ethel relocated to Chicago, Illinois where she blossomed to a beautiful young woman. She met Alonzo Cushmeer Sr. and in 1943 the two were united in marriage. To this union two sons, Alonzo Cushmeer Jr. and Jerome Cushmeer were born. Seven years later in 1950, she met and married Charlie B. Patton. To this union, one daughter Roslyn Patton was born.

Ethel followed in her mother, Mary McCains footsteps and after a study of God's word the Bible, Ethel dedicated her life to Jehovah and symbolized her dedication through water immersion on September 1, 1956, becoming one of Jehovah's Witnesses. What Ethel learned she wanted to teach to others, so she was always preaching the good news of God's Kingdom to all who would hear and on September 1, 1959, she became a regular pioneer. She served Jehovah faithfully for 56 years, and of that 53 years as a full time minister.
