



Eunice Della Peppers

May 6, 1925 - October 10, 2014

Eunice Della Peppers was born May 6, 1925 in Carrollton, Missouri to William and Katie Byron (née Cleeton). She was the youngest of six children.

She was always studious; she graduated high school two years early as class valedictorian, and after moving to Chicago in 1941, she attended Roosevelt University.

After moving to Chicago, Eunice met Joel B. Peppers of Chicago, IL, and the two were united in marriage on December 1, 1943. To this union five children were born.

Eunice worked for the Red Cross and later with the City of Chicago, in City Hall and the Department of Health, until her retirement.

Even before becoming one of Jehovah's Witnesses, Eunice was receptive to the truth, accepted theocratic literature, and visited the Kingdom Hall with her young children. This paved the way for her children to later recognize the "pure language" of the truth, and eventually she joined them as one of Jehovah's Witnesses symbolizing her dedication to Jehovah through water baptism in September, 1975.

On Friday, October 11, 2014, Eunice fell asleep in death. She is preceded in

death by her husband Joel, her son Harley, her sisters Hester and Marvella, and brothers Harley, Hughes and Oather.

Eunice leaves to cherish her memories her children: Eunice, Joel (Ethel), Joyce and Garth; seven grandchildren; ten great-grandchildren; and a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.
