Fannie Mae Harris was born on February 23, 1935 to Ada Burns Minor and Luther Davis in Tuscaloosa, Alabama. She often spoke affectionately of her mother, Ada, saying she was the best.

At a young age of 15 years old, Fannie married Clyde Roosevelt Harris on December 24, 1951. They were married 66 years and to this union five children were born.
