Frank C. Cole was born on February 8, 1943 in Chicago Heights, Illinois to the union of Clifton and Addie Cole. He was the fifth of seven children to their union and grew up under the spiritual tutelage of not only his parents but also his grandfather Bishop Blanche Cole at Cole's Temple Church of God In Christ. Frank was raised in East Chicago Heights (now Ford Heights) where he attended Bloom High School. He accepted Christ and was baptized as a young boy and served the Lord wholeheartedly.
