Frederic Stanley Douglas was born on July 18, 1937 in Little Rock, Arkansas to Frederica Crossley and Georgia Lewis Douglas. To that union were born seven children.

Frederic attended Dunbar High School (class of 1955) prior to locating to Chicago, Illinois, where he met his beloved wife, Carrie Thompson. They married on September 20, 1964. She affectionately called him "Precious" and they were together for 47 years. That 47 year union resulted in his only child, Dr. Frederica Douglas, that he constantly encouraged to make Jehovah first in her life. In addition, he was a successful restaurateur and businessman for over 25 years before selling his business to the famous Curt's bar-b-que and retiring.
