Hattie Mae Johnson was born September 13, 1929 to the union of Olivia and George Carter. She was the fourth of six children in a small town of Myersville, Mississippi.

She left Mississippi and headed North to pursue her education in Chicago, Illinois.

Hattie was blessed with a wonderful gift of sewing. There was nothing she could not make or duplicate, be it a dress in the window at Macy's or a pattern from Vogue. If she saw it, she could make it. That gift led her to be a seamstress for Albert Givens clothing factory in Michigan City, Indiana after 25 years of excellent service she retired.

Hattie was an active member of New Mt. Moriah Church in Gary, Indiana, under the leadership of Rev. Reed. She served in the church on the Nurses Board, and actively participated and coordinated many fashion shows where she would sew into the middle of the night to ensure her designer originals would hit the runway. Although her sickness kept her away from the sanctuary, she never stopped serving. She was one of Gary's best "Homemade Biscuit Maker", and Wedding and Prom dress seamstress.

After her health failed further in 2005, she moved to Hazel Crest, IL with her

sister Ernestine until she was “chosen”...as she would often say. “ I just might get chosen today.”

On December 2, 2014, Hattie was chosen to take her rest. Her mother, father, two brothers, one sister and her husband preceded her in death.

Hattie leaves to cherish her memory, one brother, Jerome Brooks (Pearl); one sister, Ernestine Thompson; and a host of special nieces, nephews, cousins, family and dear friends.
