Hilda Jones was born to Mr. Phillip and Mrs. Cora Redford in New Iberia, Louisiana on September 11, 1924.

Hilda met Charles Andrew Jones who proposed marriage. The two were united in holy matrimony on January 29, 1949. Their union was blessed with six daughters and one son. They were very proud parents who loved their children very much.

After relocating to Chicago, Illinois, Hilda attended nursing school where she worked as a nurse at Cook County Hospital in the 1950's.

Meanwhile raising her family, Sister Rosa Hudson rung the doorbell and the Bible discussion began. She for the first time saw Jehovah God's name in her own Bible. She felt so cheated that neither the Catholic school, Baptist, Methodist, and preachers of other churches where she was educated and attended never once showed her Psalm 83:18 that 'Jehovah is the Most High God.' Additionally, she learned, Jesus never said, that he was God, but that he was God's son at John 10:36, Jesus says "Do you say to me whom the Father sanctified and dispatched into the world, you blaspheme, because I said, I am God's son? Also, John 20:31 says, "But these have been written down that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ the Son of God, and that, because of believing, you may have life by means of his name."

After having a serious Bible study program for 3 years, on November 23, 1957, Hilda symbolized her dedication to Jehovah by water baptism becoming one of Jehovah's Witnesses.
