Jarrid Lanier Chaney was born on November 6, 1996 at 1:19 am, at Ingall's Memorial Hospital in Harvey, Illinois. Jarrid was the first born son to LaTonya Burnett and Raymond Chaney. Jarrid was preceded in death by his maternal grandmother Debra Harris, his great grandparents Ruthie Burnett, Martha and Vellar McCary, and two great aunts Sallie White and Ernestine Swearnigan.

In his early years, Jarrid was a member of the Sunshine Choir at St. Mark Missionary Baptist Church in Harvey, IL. Along with his parents and brother, Jarrid began attending New Faith Baptist Church International in 2008, where he enjoyed youth service so much that he was the first in the family to make the commitment of membership and was baptized.

Jarrid attended Serena Hills Elementary School, Parker Junior High School, and Homewood-Flossmoor High School, where his teachers often shared how much they adored him as a student. As a high school student, Jarrid participated in the sport of wrestling and his artistic skills flourished. Jarrid could sit and draw for hours. The result was always something of a masterpiece. Upon completion of his senior year a full semester ahead of his peers, Jarrid studied at Prairie State College. He made the bold decision to leave school and pursue his love of art in the form of tattooing.

As he matured into a young man, Jarrid moved to Champagne, IL, where he

worked in the food service industry. He wanted to live life on his own. With pleas from his mom, he returned to the south suburbs to garner support from his family. On September 30, 2019, Jarrid suffered a debilitating asthma attack. For the next 3 years and 4 months, Jarrid took care at Landmark of Richton Park. On January 30, at Franciscan St. James Hospital-Olympia Fields, restoration took place as Jarrid gained his heavenly wings.

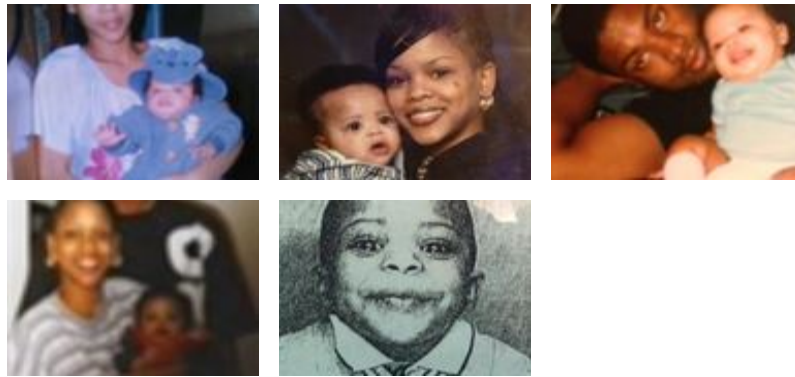
