John Henry Dunn was born in the state of Mississippi on April 1, 1934 to Roy and Lula-Mae Dunn. John was the youngest of three children, one brother and one sister.

John migrated to Chicago, Illinois in 1952 with his Uncle Charlie. He began working at a Chicago factory where he later retired. John moved to 43rd Street in 1954 and never left. He not only lived on 43rd Street, but he became a part of the historical area. If asked why he loved 43rd Street, he would say "what better place is there."

Shortly after retirement, he became an entrepreneur by owning his own hall off of 63rd and Ashland. John gave up the pool hall and took on other adventures. He worked until the last six months of his life. He was a honest, hardworking black man.

John was a two time cancer survivor and made his transition due to heart failure on May 8, 2012 at 10:16 a.m. at Mercy Hospital in Chicago. He is preceded in death by his parents, Roy and Lula-Mae Dunn; one brother, one sister, eight uncles and six aunts.

John is survived by his three daughters, Mercelle, Beverly and Doreen; grandchildren, Sherise, Takela, Nakeisha, Sharnell, Darnell, Darrin, Michael,

Taisha, Tabitha, Bridgett, Mercelle and Beverly; and a host of great grandchildren, other family members and friends.
