She told her mom and dad that although she had "this cancer", she enjoyed going to school when her health permitted.

Kayla loved family. She and her brother Tristan had a special relationship, a brother sister bond that was evident in the way they talked, fought and cared for each other. Aunt Connie was more than just an aunt, she taught Kayla French and the two shared a love of everything Parisian. And then there were the best friends Amaria, Layla and Zia, sisters from another mother.

Jehovah God was at the center of Kayla's life. Her parents clear understanding of Hebrews 10:24-25 helped her have a strong spiritual routine that included regular meeting attendance, field service, personal study, meditation and prayer. The families love and acts of faith in our Sovereign Lord Jehovah impressed upon Kayla her need to have a personal relationship with God and to dedicate her life to him. So in spite of her cancer, faith in God

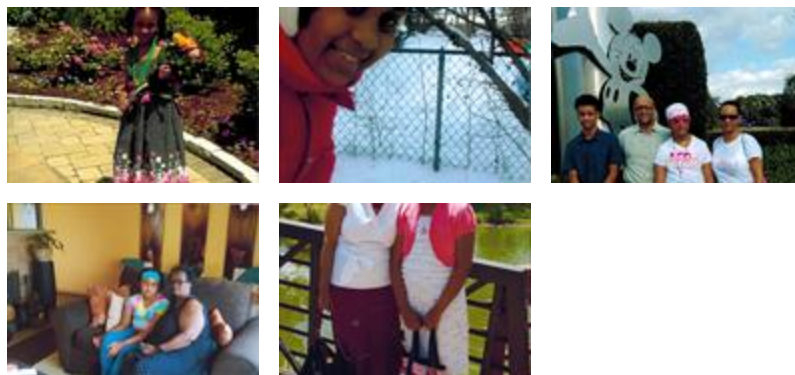
