Leonard Mohead, Jr. was born in Carroll County, Mississippi to Janie and Leonard Mohead, Sr. on October 16, 1934. The family moved to Chicago in 1953. Leonard graduated from DuSable High School and spent four years in naval aviation. He then worked for 10 years at the US Post Office. Leonard started a successful business in floor care and carpet cleaning in 1980 and maintained it for 20 years.

Leonard's Life really began when he met his dear wife Beverly in 1965. After a whirlwind relationship they were married on April 23, 1966.

Beverly started studying with Jehovah's Witnesses and on June 19, 1966 she dedicated her life to Jehovah. Leonard noticed how the Truth was changing her life and he started a study which led to his baptism on January 3, 1969. Leonard had a very humorous side, he loved to laugh and even after laughing so loud he would cry. He loved to play bid whist and bowl, he also loved to watch golf on TV although he never played it.
