Lillie was born to the union of Jessie and Rosie (Young) Fields in New Madrid, Missouri on March 22, 1940.

After moving to Chicago Heights, Illinois in 1942, and then to Ford Heights in 1944, Lillie attended and graduated from Cottage Grove School. She went on to graduate from Bloom High School in 1959.

In 1959, after graduating high school, Lillie went to work at Mount Sinai Hospital in Chicago, IL. In 1960, she began working for St. James Hospital in Chicago Heights until 1992.
