Lloyd W. Nalls was born November 14, 1943 in Chicago, Illinois to the union of Emmett and Mamie Nalls. He was the third of five boys.

Lloyd accepted Christ at an early age. He actively attended Holy Angels Church.

Lloyd graduated from Oakland Grammar School and attended Dunbar High School. After high school, he began his working career at Continental Can, Libby McNeal and Libby, as well as Ford Motor Company. From there he opened his own business, Lloyd's Heating and Air Conditioning where he was self employed until his retirement.
