Lucille Marlyn Jackson (Tut) was born in Blytheville, Arkansas on March 20th 1935 to the union of Thomas F. Jackson and Lucille Holloway Jackson. She later moved to Mound Bayou, Mississippi where she spent her early years.

Lucille relocated to Chicago, Illinois in 1954, where she met and married her high school sweetheart George Coleman in 1956. To this union was five siblings. George preceded her in death in 1990 their youngest son Tony preceded her in death in 2011.

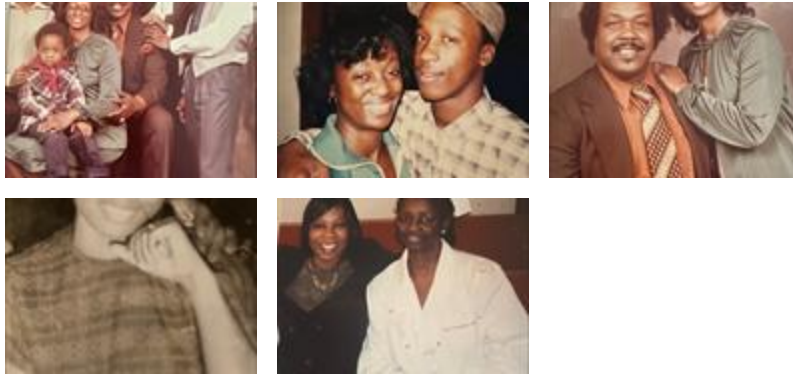
