Lula Mae Snipes was born in Brownsville, Tennessee on August 29, 1930 to Lula and Johnny Snipes. She was the seventh of nine children born to this union.

The Snipes family moved to Bells, TN. Lula received her education through the Bells School System. She was known to be a quiet and reserved person.

In 1945, Lula united in marriage with James Giles and they were married for a short period of time. In 1951, Lula moved to Chicago, Illinois. On October 3, 1969 she united in marriage with Shead Butler.

After many years of careful studying of the Bible, Lula dedicated her life to Jehovah and symbolized her dedication through water baptism becoming one of Jehovah's Witnesses.
