On November 4, 1923, a third child was born to Alonzo and Willie Fredna Patton in Toomsaba, Mississippi. She was given the name Mable.

Mable attended elementary school in Meridian, Mississippi and she graduated from T. J. Harris High School in 1942. She was always known as a serious student and was voted most likely to succeed. After graduating from high school and taking classes at Jackson College, she married and gave birth to five wonderful children: Gary, Margaret, Janice, Vaneda and Kathryn. Her children were the love of her life.

Later, after moving to Chicago and having a variety of employment experiences, she began to search for answers to many of life's most intriguing questions. This led to a serious study of the Bible where she found those answers. Mable dedicated her life to Jehovah and in 1968 she symbolized her dedication through water baptism becoming one of Jehovah's Witnesses. She was well known for her strong stand on Bible truth and her ministry produced many fine results. Just days before her death she was still ardently witnessing to anyone she came in contact with.
