Martha E. McEwen-Moore, affectionately known as "Marty" to her family, was born on December 15, 1938, in Chicago, Illinois, to the union of Deloris and Ernest Ashley. She was the oldest of 4 children. After graduating from Elementary School, Martha attended Lucy Flower Technical High School for Girls. She completed her education at Hyde Park Academy. Martha had strong family values and immensely enjoyed attending family reunions and gatherings.

On December 31, 1954, Martha was united in marriage to Chesleigh McEwen. From this union, five children were born. Chesleigh preceded her in death on January 8, 1990.

Martha became employed at the United States Postal Service in 1968, and worked there for 23 years. Her love for people allowed her to form long-term friendships with her fellow postal colleagues; and thus developed a love for traveling. Martha traveled to many extraordinary places, including Spain, Jamaica and The Virgin islands. While visiting New York City, she and her work colleagues bumped into The Jackson 5.
