Michael Kevin Jones was born on October 12, 1961, to the union of Albert and Velma Jones in Chicago, Illinois. He was the fourth of five children. He was affectionately known as Kevin to his family and friends.

Kevin received his formal education through the Chicago Public School System.

Kevin dedicated his life and symbolized his dedication through water baptism on April 25, 1976 and remained a single faithful servant for 45 years. Kevin's love for Jehovah and his faithful servants was unwavering. He had many privileges of service including serving as a Ministerial Servant and then as an Elder at the Beverly and Homewood Congregations. He also served in different capacities such as Account Servant, Watchtower Conductor, Congregation Secretary, Coordinator of Audio/Visual. He was happy to volunteer for many Regional Conventions and Circuit Assemblies. He enjoyed serving in the News Service Department for many years and for a few years he had the privilege of serving as the Coordinator in that Department. He had the opportunity to serve as Assembly Coordinator, conduct the Watchtower Study and give talks at the Regional and Circuit Assemblies.

Kevin's attention to detail in everything he did was always of the utmost importance to him.

On September 24, 1983 he married Gina Mathis the love of his life and best friend. They were married for 37 years. Through their union, Brandon Michael Jones, was born in June, 1999. Brandon meant everything to Kevin. The person he poured everything into and gained much in return. He was an excellent father, role model and husband and enjoyed a very close and loving relationship with his wife and son Brandon. He was the best husband a wife could ever have. His main concern was taking care of his family. He was an excellent provider.

In 2019, Kevin and his family were privileged to attend the Love Never Fails International Convention in Paris, France. He would comment that it changed his life.

Kevin was joyful and full of life, a quick-witted natural comedian whose personality was magnetic. Kevin had a great love of music and taught himself how to play lead, base guitar, drums and piano. A musician and a performer Kevin touched those around him with his gift for musical instruments. Even as a child Kevin could be seen with a set of drumsticks in his hand.

In 2005, Kevin and Gina opened Popper-Razzi Gourmet Popcorn in Hazel Crest, IL. His attention to detail and love for his customers made his popcorn stand above the crowd. In this regard Kevin won many awards and has garnered a faithful following.

Kevin's impact on the lives of the young men who worked with him over the years at Popper-Razzi cannot be overlooked. For example, from the laughs he got out of A.D. to the heart to hearts he had with Chris to the lively, entertaining discussions with Daniel he had a profound effect on all of his employees. But non compared to the relationship he had with his right-hand man Rueben. Rueben would tell Kevin he was the "dark-skinned charming

son” he never had. Kevin would laugh but viewed him as such, as they loyally supported each other for over 13 years.

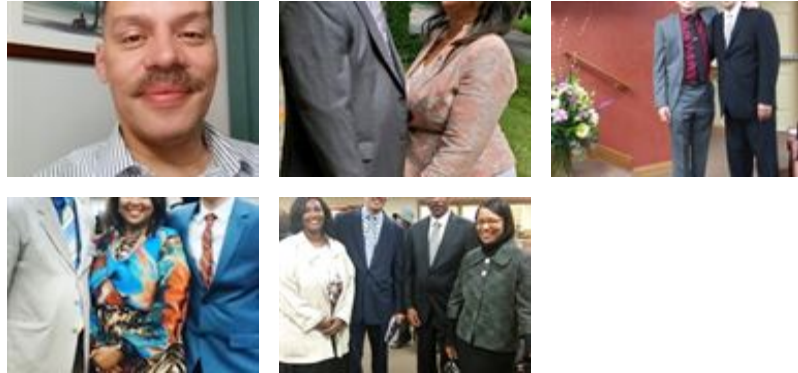

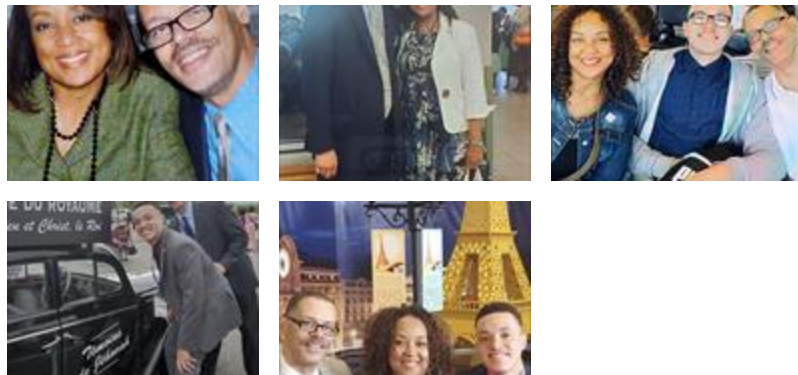
