Misty Marie McElwee was born to Henry and Patricia McElwee on April 13, 1967, in Chicago, IL.

In 1999, Misty graduated from Chicago State University and became an educator. Many were the milestones Misty achieved as an educator. However, her true career, the career that gave her the most joy, was being a servant of Jehovah. In April of 1987, Misty began studying with Jehovah's Witnesses. On June 27, 1987, she dedicated her life, got baptized, and became one of Jehovah's Witnesses. Six months after baptism, she became a fulltime pioneer, dedicating 90 hours a month toward preaching and teaching the Bible. She pioneered for about 5 years. Although she was unable to continue with pioneering, she loved the preaching work so much that she helped other family members dedicate their lives to Jehovah. Many of these family members later became regular pioneers and continue in the work.

On June 18, 2022, Misty fell asleep in death.
