Myrtice Sylvia Turner was born November 7, 1920 to the union of Charles and Rose Lyons in Cleveland, Ohio.

Myrtice attended and graduated from Central High School in January 1939. She was especially known for her love of the English language. She was also remembered for her "pleasing personality" in school.

On July 24, 1940, Myrtice married Swanson Howell Turner. To this union three sons were born, David, Douglas and Dennis. She remained devotedly married for 54 years until Swanson's death on July 18, 1994. Myrtice was known for her love and devotion to her large family of brothers, sisters, their children and family vacations. She also loved the arts, theatre and traveling.

While raising her family, Myrtice became close friends with two of Jehovah's Witnesses, James and Odessa Lockhart, whom helped both her and her husband to become active in studying and applying Bible principles. She dedicated her life to Jehovah and symbolized her dedication by water baptism on June 4, 1960. Having a genuine love and zeal for God's word, she demonstrated this love by actively following Jesus commandment at Matthew 28:19 to go and make disciples. She would often pioneer and regularly being energetic in the field ministry. She assisted many people in learning about Jehovah, some of whom also dedicated their lives and became baptized.

On April 4, 2017, Myrtice fell asleep in death and now rests while awaiting her unshakeable belief in the words of Jesus found at John 5:28 and 29. She was preceded in death by her parents, Charles and Rose; her husband, Swanson; and two sons, David and Douglas.

Myrtice leaves to cherish her memory, one sister, Carol; one son, Dennis; three daughters-in-law, Ruby, Martha and Debra Turner; four grandchildren, Bonnie (Harlan) Jackson, Rhondalyn Turner, Troy Turner and Todd (Holly) Turner; nine great grandchildren, Desiree, Jonathan, Devon, Charlotte, Lauren, Danielle, William, Allison and Jeremy; and a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.
