



## Rebecca Redmond

April 18, 1924 - March 4, 2014

Rebecca Patton, affectionately called “Becky or Bit”, was born in Uniontown, Alabama on April 18, 1924 to parents Callie and Phil Patton Sr. She was the second oldest of eight children.

Becky accepted Christ into her life at an early age at Friendship Baptist Church in Uniontown, AL.

As a young woman, Becky moved to Chicago, Illinois, where she met and married Sam Redmond. Her husband Sam, her daughter Carrie Montgomery, and her grandson Emiel Valentino Montgomery provided a joyful home for her. Family and her love for her family, was most important to her. Becky was a longtime member at Greater Pleasant Valley M.B. Church in Chicago, where she faithfully served on the usher board for many years.

Although she had a great sense of humor and loved to laugh, Becky was quick to tell you, “I am no play thing, if you want something to play with, you better go to the five and dime store.”
