Roosevelt Simpson was born on March 3, 1944 in West Memphis, Arkansas to the union of Troy and Irene Simpson.

Roosevelt accepted Christ at an early age at Beautiful Zion M.B.C. in West Memphis, Arkansas, where he was also a member of the church choir. After moving to Chicago, Roosevelt later became a member of Holy Cathedral under Bishop Lindsey.

Roosevelt worked for the City of Chicago with the Cement Crew as a Jack Hammer Operator for a number of years and also became very involved in political volunteer work in several wards of Chicago. Later he drove taxi cabs for several years.

On Monday, July 27, 2015, Roosevelt Simpson made his transition.
