



## Rosie Mae Mackey

June 11, 1924 - January 26, 2014

Rosie Mae Garner was born June 11, 1924, in Tell, Texas to the union of Carrie Frost Garner and Eddie Garner. Rosie Mae married Morris Mackey in February 1940 in Simsboro, Louisiana.

Rosie Mae Mackey was affectionately called Mudear (an abbreviation for mother dear) by her family. To truly know Sister Mackey (Mudear) was to love her. It was quite evident that her adornment was that of "the quiet and mild spirit, which is of great value in the eyes of God." (1 Peter 3:4)

Her warm personality and generous spirit caused her to be dearly loved by her family and others that knew her. The abundant love that she demonstrated for her God Jehovah, her family and others will never be forgotten.

She demonstrated her love for God, by becoming one of his Witnesses. On January 30, 1966, Rosie dedicated her life to Jehovah and symbolized it by water baptism. Her love and appreciation for knowing what the Bible really teaches lead her to joining the full time ministry to teach others about Jehovah. So on September 1, 1990 after retiring from her secular work, Sister Mackey started devoting 90 hours a month in preaching and teaching others Bible truths. Most of the time, Mudear would do more than 90 hours a month, so that she could devote that month of August, to help care for her own mother, Carrie until her death.

On Sunday, January 26, 2014, Rosie Mae fell asleep in death. She was preceded in death by her parents: Carrie and Eddie Garner; her husband: Morris Mackey; and siblings: Louis P. Garner, Helen Frazier, Levell Garner, Sr., and Eddie Mae Hawthorne.
