Rozener Swarn was born to the late Alma and Enoch Dawson in Folsom, Louisiana on the 27th day of January, 1922. She was the only child born from this union. Sometime later, she united with her other brothers and sisters from Michigan and Louisiana. Rozener resided in various cities in the South and eventually settled in Chicago, Illinois in 1956.

She was blessed with a large family. She married at a young age to Robert Trull, Sr., to that union they had 5 children. She later married James Edward Swarn, together they raised 10 more children. They cherished their family and instilled in all of them “a mother’s love”, discipline, and hard work. That love, in turn, blossomed into multiple generations. Both Robert and James preceded her in death.

Rozener was well known and earned the title of being a hard worker but she was also an educator in heart. She worked for many years; retired from the food service industry at the prestigious Drake Hotel and Ritz Carleton in Chicago, IL. 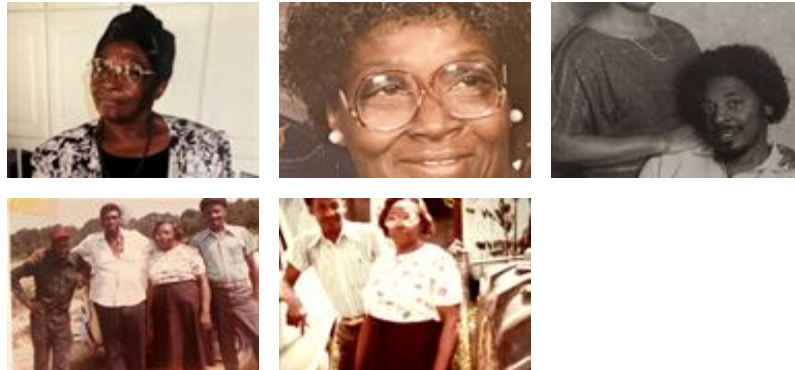
