Theodore Roosevelt Gibbons was born October 5, 1955 to Emmer and Samuel Gibbons. Theodore was the 4th oldest of eight children. Theodore was affectionally known as Ted and Fee.

Theodore attended Holy Angels Catholic School from Kindergarten through eighth grade. Theodore was a graduate of St. Michael High School. After high school, Theodore enlisted in the U.S. Navy in 1974 – 1975. Theodore's specialized training included 'Fire Control and Firefighter Damage Control' training before he received an honorable discharge from the Navy.
