Thomas Thornton Phillips was born January 20, 1931 in Allegheny, Pennsylvania to Julia and Thomas Phillips. He was the third child of ten siblings.

In 1952, Thomas enlisted in the Air Force and was honorably discharged in 1956. He loved flying and riding his Harley Davidson.

In 1969, Thomas earned his Brokers license and specialized in selling commercial Real Estate. He was employed by Jewel Food Stores to sell all their closed stores on the south side of Chicago. He also sold forty church properties earning him the name "Church Salesman".

Tom was best known for his sense of humor. When asked how he felt, he would reply: "I feel delicious". When caught telling a lie, he would say: "This is the first lie I told all year."
