Verdina Bowers Davis was born to the union of James and Bertha Bowers on April 23, 1945 in East Chicago, Indiana. She was one of nine children.

Verdina was affectionately known as Dina. She attended and graduated from Thornton Township High School. Dina then, went on to Dental College to become a Dental Hygienist.

Dina worked for Montgomery Wards in the department of Windy Wards Modeling. She was in the Tribune newspaper in 1969 for helping young teens apply for the International Teen Princess pageant.

Dina met and then married the love of her life, Samuel L. Davis. From that union, three children were born. Sam and Dina had a strong love for family. When Dina's mother took ill, they adopted Dina's baby sister, Grace Bowers and raised her as their daughter.

Verdina dedicated her life to Jehovah, symbolized her dedication through water baptism becoming one of Jehovah's Witnesses in 1970. Dina loved preaching and teaching others about Jehovah. She became a full time evangelizer in 1988. She helped over 30 people to dedicate their lives to Jehovah with the help of her Pioneer partner Ruth Cary.
